Dear Parents / Carers,

We are very much looking forward to welcoming our Year 8 pupils back to school tomorrow.

Could we kindly ask you to remind your child of the following before returning to school tomorrow:

- Importance of regular hand washing
- Social distance 2M rule
- Coughing into a tissue or elbow
- No travelling on the bus without prior confirmation of a seat
- Importance of best behaviour on the school bus and in school
- No chewing gum
- A lunch box and plenty of cold drinks
- School uniform rules i.e. polo shirt, school trousers/skirt, school shoes
- Follow one way systems on all occasions
- No leaving school premises
- Remember a pen
- No sharing of equipment
- Keep to the designated zones during break times and lunch times

SCHOOL ARRIVAL TIMES:

- Pupils accessing Hwb provision to arrive at **8.00am**
- Pupils who have permission to make use of school transport to arrive at school between **8.20am – 8.45am**
- Pupils travelling by school transport to adhere to social distancing measures put in place and to remain in their allocated seat for the duration of the journey
- Pupils who will walk to school to arrive at **9.00am**
- Pupils who arrive at school via car to arrive at **9.15am**. *We kindly ask all parents not to enter the school car park until 9.15am to avoid congestion and ensure safety of all. These pupils to remain in car until further notice from member of staff on duty in the car park. Parents / Carers to remain in car at all times.*

*** ANNOUNCEMENT TO PARENTS / CARERS ***

During the weekend we encountered an issue with bees in a specific area of the school site. A specialist company visited the school and removed all visible bees. Having visited the site this morning there are a very small number of bees present in one area of the school.

This area will not be used during the next three weeks and we have amended our school plans and our risk assessment accordingly. The Local Authority are confident that we are in a position to remain open.

However, if your child has an allergy to bees, could you please contact the school in the morning so that we can amend our medical records and ensure that we can follow the necessary precautionary measures.
