Dear Parent/Carer,

We have been advised by Public Health Wales that there has been a confirmed case of COVID-19 in Ysgol Gyfun Cwm Rhondda.

Following both Welsh Government and Local Authority guidance, as a precautionary measure, pupils in Year 11 have been asked to stay home for one day only on Monday 21/09/20, and 26 pupils from Years 10 and 11 have been identified as **close contacts** and asked to self-isolate for a period of 14 days from today. This is because it can take up to 14 days for the symptoms to develop.

The process of testing and contact tracing is part of the new normal where schools and settings are required to follow the guidelines carefully as part of the "Test, Trace, Protect" strategy that Welsh Government has adopted.

As a precautionary measure and to enable us to deep clean some areas of the school, we have requested that all Year 11 pupils to remain home on Monday 21/09/20.

All Year 11 pupils who are not part of the 'close contact' group identified should return to school on Tuesday 22/09/20 unless they have been directly contacted by the school or 'track and trace' to instruct otherwise.

If your child is part of the 'close contact' group, the school will have already contacted you via text message to let you know. If you have not received a text message , your child is expected to return to school tomorrow as usual on Tuesday 22/09/20.

The school remains open for all other pupils. Please can I reassure you we will continue to be vigilant in adhering to all guidelines so that we can keep all children and staff safe. The health and safety of everyone in our school community is of paramount importance and we appreciate your full support during these times.

We fully appreciate that this is an unfamiliar and anxious time for us all and if you would like further information, please do not hesitate to contact us directly.
