Hoffwn eich hysbysu bod yna newid i'n trefniadau gwreiddiol o safbwynt diwrnodau HMS eleni.

O ganlyniad i'n sefyllfa anghyffredin a chyfnewidiol o ran Covid-19, mae sawl aelod o'n cymuned ysgol, yn ddisgyblion, staff a rhieni, wedi mynegi consyrn nad yw cau ar 18^{fed} o Ragfyr yn caniatáu i deuluoedd hunanynysu er mwyn treulio amser gyda theuluoedd yn ddiogel dros yr Ŵyl. Dear Parent/Guardian,

A CHANGE IN INSET DAYS

I would like to make you aware that there is a change in our original plan for the INSET days this academic year.

In response to the unusual and changing situation caused by Covid-19, a significant number of our school community, including pupils, parents and staff, have expressed concern that closing on the 18th December does not allow sufficient time for families to self-isolate in preparation to spend time with other family members safely for the Christmas period. We work and live in an area with a very high proportion of Covid-19 cases, and as a result, we will need to operate in a different manner to other areas. We share a duty to protect our communities and each other, and by ensuring that our pupils are not in school after the 16th December, we create a better opportunity for families to come together safely.

Therefore, we have rearranged our INSET calendar for this academic year.

Here are the new dates for INSET days this term:

- **4th December = Whole school INSET. The school is closed to pupils.**
- **17th and 18th December = Whole school INSET. The school is closed to pupils.**

As a result of the new INSET days above, we are changing the INSET days below, and the school will remain open to pupils on the following dates:

- **4th January = The new term's start date. The school is open to pupils.**
- **16th June = The school is open to pupils.**

We understand that this is a change with a short warning period, but unfortunately this is a daily changing situation and this directly affects our planning and actions to protect our community.
