AMENDED GUIDANCE

Dear Parent / Guardian,

As a school we want to do our best to try and ensure that your child does not have to selfisolate at the start of the Summer holidays.

During the period of the 10th to the 18th of July, we kindly ask you to follow the COVID-19 guidelines in order to protect not only your holiday, but the holiday of other families with pupils within your bubble.

The School is making every effort for the final week of term to reduce the risk of your child being identified as a close contact. We kindly ask for your assistance to reinforce the following actions:

- If a pupil feels unwell, do not send them to school. Call the NHS helpline or arrange a PCR test
- Encourage Year 7 - Year 13 pupils to take LFT tests regularly. There are plenty of tests available in school if more are required
- We will continue to provide 2 medical grade face coverings daily to the pupils who need to wear them. (These coverings are more effective than the washable coverings as they are medical grade face coverings)
- Everybody must wash their hands or use sanitising fluid regularly
- Everybody needs to social distance where possible

I take this opportunity to thank you for your support and to wish you well for the Summer holidays.
