Equipment

The following equipment is needed by each pupil:

- Writing equipment, coloured pencils
- Ruler, protractor and compass.
- Scientific Calculator
- Welsh / English dictionary
- Welsh / English reading book

The use liquid corrector (e.g., Tippex) is prohibited in school.

- Parents are requested, where possible, to provide a sturdy bag to carry books.
- A softer holdall/bag may be used to carry sportswear etc.

Parents are particularly requested to ensure that each item of a pupil's belongings is marked with a pupil's name. It should be clearly and indelibly written (e.g., with indelible pen or embroidered name-tape).

Lost Property

Lost property is kept in the school office. Should any pupil find an item of lost property, he/she should take it to the office.

Transport to School

The Local Authority arranges free transport for every pupil living over two miles from the school and within its official catchment. Information will be sent out to parents during the summer holidays giving details of arrangements made.

The buses will be in the car park on the school premises to pick up and set down pupils. If problems should arise with transport, the school may be contacted initially or parents may contact the Local Authority.

Assembly

Assembly consists of a short non-denominational but Christian act of collective worship. Any parent wishing a child to be withdrawn from the above on religious grounds should inform the school in writing. Assemblies are considered an important part of pupils' education.

Attendance at School – Pupil Target = 95%

Regular attendance reflects commitment and maximises opportunities for educational achievement. At Ysgol Gyfun Cwm Rhondda, we aim to secure the highest attendance from all our pupils.

We ask parents to:

- Support good habits of regular and punctual attendance in their children.
- Contact the school before 10a.m. on the first day of any absence if your child cannot attend through illness or any other reason. If no contact is made the school will contact the parents.
- When a child is absent from school for more than one day, parents are expected to contact the school daily on the morning of the absence.
- Parents are requested not to withdraw pupils from school for family holidays
- Where possible, parents should avoid arranging medical appointments during the school day.
- While in school, absence from any lesson without permission of the teacher is considered as truancy.

Regular attendance at school is the single most important factor in your child's success.

Anti - Bullying

Our aim is to make Ysgol Gyfun Cwm Rhondda a safe, happy place for every pupil. We are committed to taking a stand against bullying and therefore ensure that any incident is dealt with immediately.

Tua diwedd Blwyddyn 9, gwahoddir rhieni a disgyblion Blwyddyn 9 i Noson Opsiynau yn yr ysgol, pan fydd cyfle i drafod gyda Swyddogion Gyrfaoedd ac athrawon cyn gwneud penderfyniadau ynglyn â phynciau dewisol CA4 (blynyddoedd 10 ac 11).

Physical Education and Sport

The aim of the Physical Education Department is to introduce pupils to a broad range of learning opportunities so as to develop physical fitness, cooperation, practical skills, information and understanding. Pupils are encouraged to value fair-play, to accept competition in a positive manner and to develop their own self-confidence.

Instrumental Lessons

Lessons are offered on the following instruments:

- violin

- singing

These lessons are on a rota basis to ensure that pupils do not miss lessons in the same subjects regularly. A termly fee will be charged for these lessons.

Careers Guidance

From Year 9 onwards, pupils will be offered relevant careers advice. In addition to a programme of provision provided by the school, a Local Authority Careers Officer and other appropriate specialists are brought into the school. Parents may arrange to see the Careers Officer to discuss their children's career pathways. Pupils can consult their teachers for help and guidance as the need arises.

Towards the end of Year 9, parents and Year 9 pupils will be invited to the Options Evening at the school, when they will have the opportunity for discussion with Careers Officers and teachers before decisions on the course of study for KS4 (Years 10 & 11) are made.

Supportive School Policing Initiatives

(All Wales School Liaison Core Programme)

The school actively works in partnership with the South Wales Police Service to deliver a Supportive School Policing initiative that aim to:

- educate children and young people about the harm substance misuse can cause to their health, their families and the wider community
- promote the principles of positive citizenship through the medium of education
- achieve a reduction in the levels of crime and disorder within our young communities

The schools designated Police officer is trained to deliver lessons on the themes of substance misuse, personal safety, safeguarding and behaviour and community to a best practice educational standard that is welcomed by the school.

Medication

The school does not administer medication such as pain killers without your permission. Parents are asked to contact the school should a pupil require medication during school hours. Any such medication should be placed in the school office for safekeeping and will be given to the pupil under supervision.

Illness or Accident at School

If a pupil is taken ill at school parents are contacted to collect him if it is thought necessary. If a pupil has an accident at school and a hospital visit is thought necessary parents will be contacted at the first available opportunity. Only in emergency situations, if it is impossible for a parent to make the journey, a teacher or delegated member of staff will take the pupil to hospital.

School Trips / Extra Curricular Activities

We firmly believe in providing rich and varied extra-curricular activities for our pupils. If your child will be leaving the school site to attend a pre-arranged activity during the school day, you will be informed beforehand. We ask parents to read and sign the **Consent Form for Usual Extra-Curricular Activities, found in the Pupil Organiser** at the start of every academic year.

Year 7-11 pupils are not allowed to leave the school site. Contravening this will be regarded as a serious breach of school rules.

We ask all visitors to report to the main Reception, where they are issued with a red visitor lanyard for easy identification around the school.

A number of staff are qualified First Aiders are trained to assist pupils with minor medical problems.

We make every effort to ensure that the school environment is a safe place for everyone to work and we have a comprehensive Health and Safety policy that is available from the school on request.
